NORTH CAROLINA LEAGUE OF MUNICIPALITIES Technical Assistance Grant Program

The North Carolina League of Municipalities (NCLM) designated their ARP funding to support local municipalities with their grant readiness. Due to the historic amount of funding available at the federal and state levels, they assessed and identified grant services as a priority for community growth. NCLM contracted with Witt O'Brien's (WOB) to provide Technical Assistance (TA) in three key areas: Grant Identification, Grant Pursuance, and Grant Management. The following is an update on grants submitted through this program thus far:

FEMA ASSISTANCE TO FIRE FIGHTERS GRANT (AFG):

This grant was submitted to address needs related to Personal Protective Equipment with a possible award of \$81,825.91. The strategy is to relieve pressure on the budget to assist with funding the repair of the two Command/Mobile Communications Vehicles discussed above. The AFG grant does not fund these types of vehicles so the replacement of the needed PPE and equipment that was damaged or aged out will relieve the pressure to the budget to continue fixing the needed vehicles.

SAFE STREETS FOR ALL (SS4A):

This grant was applied to facilitate the development of an Action Plan needed for implementation of a multimodal street network for the town. This was submitted on May 15, 2024 in the amount of \$120,000. If awarded it places Hope Mills in the position to apply for a SS4A implementation grant in FY25.

FIREHOUSE SUBS GRANT:

The initial purpose of the grant is to impact the lifesaving capabilities and lives of local heroes and their communities. This is accomplished by providing lifesaving equipment and prevention education tools to first responders and public safety organizations. The town is applying for the third quarter Firehouse Subs grant on July 11, 2024 to fund bullet proof vest for the Police Department for approximately \$19,846.00.

LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND GRANT (LWCF):

The Land and Water Conversation Fund has historically been a primary funding source of the US Department of the Interior for outdoor recreation development and land acquisition. Since 1965, the LWCF program has built a permanent park legacy for present and future generations. In North Carolina alone, this program has provided more than \$85 million in matching grants to support more than 900 state and local park projects. Hope Mills is hearing up to submit an application for this grant in September of 2024.

TOWN OF HOPE MILLS PROJECTS and ACTIVITIES

HOPE MILLS PARKS AND RECREATION UPDATE:

Parks and Rec staff has installed 2 new canopies between the new splash pad and phase 1 of the all inclusive playground. As they proceed towards the completion of phase 2 of the Reid's Journey playground, benches will be installed under these new canopies for seating.



HOPE MILLS PUBLIC WORKS UPDATE:

LANE CLOSURES: Starting on June 8, 2024 at 8:00pm until June 10, 2024 at 6:00am there will be lane closures on the east bound lane of Main Street and the north bound lane far east lane of Golfview.

HOPE MILLS LAKE MULTI-USE PATH: Public works staff is currently evaluating the CEI package with a total of \$44,238 dollars incurred to date. The \$499,200 dollar project is 9% complete.

VETERANS MEMORIAL PARKING LOT UPDATE

Construction is still underway with the sidewalks, curb and gutter, and storm drainage complete. Constructors have also installed the sub-base with completion anticipated by mid-june.
