TOWN OF HOPE MILLS PROJECTS and ACTIVITIES

HOPE MILLS PARKS AND RECREATION UPDATE:

VETERANS PARKING LOT: The new parking lot for the Veterans Memorial portion of Hope Mills Park is now open. Parking is now available directly adjacent to the memorial to provide better access for our veterans.

HERITAGE PARK: Contractors are continuing work at Heritage Park in Hope Mills. The footings are being poured for the erecting of the old damn gates as canopies and the framing for the proposed bathrooms are underway.



HOPE MILLS PUBLIC WORKS UPDATE:

STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS: Public works staff is currently reviewing proposed amendments to the Hope Mills Standards and Specifications Manual. As this manual regulates that standards of construction for residential and commercial infrastructure, the Hope Mills Plan Review team is currently analyzing trends to determine final staff recommendations.

HOPE MILLS GRANTS:

Witt O'Brien has submitted the grant application for the Firehouse Subs Grant for a total of \$19,905 for 30 large bullet proof vests which will fill voids within the Police Department with respect to safety equipment.

HOPE MILLS LAKE

Hope Mills Lake is one of our most cherished assets centrally located in the heart of our Town. Many of the lake amenities from the Gazebo, the kayak launch, the peir, and Big T's, to our rain garden, walking trail, and bulkhead are enjoyed by our residents and visitors alike. With a public park of this size there are rules and regulations that aid in ensuring the health and safety of our citizens:

Swimming: The posted Hope Mills Park/Lake Rules indicate that swimming is allowed from April 1st through September 30th of each year between the hours of 9:00am to 9:00pm daily. These rules also indicate that swimming is at your own risk and that it is unlawful for anyone under the age of 14 to swim unless accompanied by an adult.

Geese: As our lake is a natural habitat for wildlife, geese have been considered to be a regular presence on our grounds. As these are protected species staff has signs posted regulating the feeding of wildlife and how feeding them could increase negative impacts such as excessive feces.

Dogs: As with other regulations, there are signs posted indicating that no pets are allowed on the lake premises with the exception of service animals. Dogs on a leash with an owner are allowed but restricted to the walking trail only.

Advertising Businesses: The Town of Hope Mills has routinely prohibited the advertising of any business on any town property. Instances where advertising has been permitted are tied to joint ventures where there is a festival or event that is either sponsored by the Town or when an entity has reserved town property for a private event.
