



Request for Proposals – Guardrails

The Town of Hope Mills – Public Works Department is issuing this Request for Proposals (RFP) for assistance with guardrail repair and replacement.

Scope of Work

Includes removal/replacement, as needed, installation, traffic control, and restoration per NCDOT standards. Includes removal of damaged guardrail, installation of new W-beam systems, traffic control per MUTCD and NCDOT standards, and cleanup. All materials must meet NCDOT Standard Specifications Section 862 and FHWA requirements.

The town of Hope Mills has four guardrail locations where maintenance, repair, and replacement are required. See attached sheet for a description and location of guardrails for improvements. The scope of work for this project includes the following tasks, but is not limited to:

1. Removal and disposal of all damaged materials.
2. Installation and repair of listed sections of guardrails. The contractor will be allowed to reuse existing guardrail if they are in good condition. Additionally, the use of used posts and guardrail sections will be allowed.
3. Installation of butterfly reflective markers, as needed.
4. The work generally consists of replacing and/or resetting posts, re-bolting rail sections in place, and replacing damaged rail and posts.
5. This work shall be completed by **June 30, 2026**.

Guardrails for repair, Town of Hope Mills



1. Lakeview Road south side across from Hope Mills Dam

- a. End of guardrail has major damage
- b. Reset/replace post as needed
- c. Repair damaged sections
- d. Replace/repair tensioning device as needed



2. Lakeview Road north side near intersection with Lakeshore Drive

- a. End Cap to be replaced



3. Lakeview Road northside closest to Main Street

- a. Section of guardrail damaged
- b. Repair/Replace
- c. Several posts and blocks damaged



4. Lakeview Road northside, dam side

- a. Post damaged
- b. Repair/replace as needed
- c. Fastening bolt missing



5. Replace Reflective material on all endcaps (4)
